WHEREAS, Daniel Kosiba was a Niles Park District Commissioner from 1977 to 1985, serving as president in 1979, 1980, and 1981, and he was instrumental as president in starting youth soccer; he was a board member, coach, and manager for the Niles Baseball League; he was the St. John Brebeuf Athletic Director, where in the 1970s, he highlighted the importance of offering sports for girls as well as for boys; he also served as the Niles Park District Athletic Director and the Niles West High School Junior Wolves Baseball Feeder Program Director; and

WHEREAS, Daniel Kosiba was a member of the North American Martyrs Knights of Columbus, where he coordinated the annual holiday basketball tournament at St. John Brebeuf, which had over 200 basketball teams/cheerleading squads competing during
