1 HOUSE RESOLUTION

- 2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois House of 3 Representatives wish to congratulate the officers of the Ogle 4 County Sheriff's Office for their courageous work at the gated 5 community of Lost Lake on June 12, 2024; and
- WHEREAS, At 8:40 a.m., police were informed that a man living in the 400 block of Wild Rice Lane was having suicidal and homicidal ideations; the sheriff's office promptly dispatched officers to the location; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Upon arriving at the house shortly after 9 a.m.,
 11 deputies learned that the man was armed with multiple
 12 firearms; this prompted the Ogle County authorities to
 13 activate its emergency response team, which arrived on the
 14 scene about 10:20 a.m.; and
- 15 WHEREAS, After more than an hour of attempted calls made 16 by negotiators to the suspect's phone, the sheriff's office 17 made the decision to enter the residence; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Members of the emergency response team attempted 19 to enter the residence shortly before noon, immediately 20 encountering gun fire before incapacitating the suspect; the 21 emergency team located the suspect inside the front door with

- 1 multiple firearms, a blade, pepper spray, and ballistic armor;
- 2 and
- 3 WHEREAS, During the fire fight, two response team members,
- 4 Sergeant Tad Dominski and Lieutenant Jason Ketter, were
- 5 wounded while another, Tactical Officer Tyler Carls, was
- 6 struck in the armor; Carls and Dominski were transported to
- 7 KSB Hospital in Dixon, where they were treated and released
- 8 while Ketter was flown to OSF St. Anthony Medical Center in
- 9 Rockford where he underwent surgery; therefore, be it
- 10 RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE
- 11 HUNDRED THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that
- 12 we congratulate the brave officers of the Ogle County
- 13 Sheriff's Office for their valiant actions on June 12, 2024
- 14 and honor Officers Dominski, Ketter, and Carls for their
- heroic sacrifice; and be it further
- 16 RESOLVED, That suitable copies of this resolution be
- 17 presented to Officers Dominski, Ketter, and Carls and the Ogle
- 18 County Sheriff's Office as an expression of our profound
- 19 respect and gratitude.
