12 Illinois State Police from 1985 to 2004, which included the  
13 rank of trooper, sergeant, master sergeant, lieutenant,  
14 captain, and major; and

15           WHEREAS, Chief Tigera served as the deputy administrator  
16 for the Illinois Gaming Board from 2004 to 2008; and

17           WHEREAS, Chief Tigera held the rank of region one  
18 commander with the Illinois State Police from 2008 to 2009; he  
19 served as first deputy director of the Illinois State Police  
20 from 2009 to 2011; and

1           WHEREAS, Chief Tigera was named chief of police for  
2 Broadview in July of 2011, serving through April of 2017; and

3           WHEREAS, Chief Tigera returned to where his career began  
4 and became the chief of police for the Niles Police Department  
5 in July of 2017, where he led the department through a period  
6 of transformative growth and innovation; and

7           WHEREAS, Chief Tigera holds a master's degree in police  
8 administration from Lewis University and graduated as a member  
9 of the 182nd session of the FBI National Academy; and

10          WHEREAS, Chief Tigera's career will be remembered for his  
11 dedication, vision, and unwavering commitment to both his  
12 officers and the community, and he leaves behind a legacy of  
13 excellence and leadership; therefore, be it
