10	"Assistive technology" means any equipment, softw	are, or
11	product used to increase, maintain, or improve the fur	ctional
12	capabilities of individuals with disabilities, includi	ng, but
13	not limited to, screen reading and magnification so	ftware,
14	refreshable Braille displays, and speech recognition pr	ograms.

"Certified remote accessible vote by mail system" means\_

for elections that occur before the 2024 primary election, a

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process approved by the State Board of Elections through which an election authority provides for the electronic transmission of a vote by mail ballot to a voter with a print disability and through which the voter with a print disability marks and verifies the voter's ballot using assistive technology.

"Certified remote accessible vote by mail system" means, for the 2024 primary election and all subsequent elections, a process approved by the State Board of Elections through which an election authority provides for the electronic transmission of a vote by mail ballot to a voter with a print disability and through which the voter with a print disability marks, verifies, and returns the voter's ballot to the election authority electronically using assistive technology.

"Electronic transmission" means the transfer of data or information through an authorized electronic data interchange system.

"Voter with a print disability" means a person having a temporary or permanent physical or mental impairment, such as blindness, low vision, physical dexterity limitations, or learning or cognitive disabilities, that prevents the person from effective reading, writing, or use of printed material.

(b) The State Board of Elections shall provide a certified remote accessible vote by mail system for the General Election of November 8, 2022 and all subsequent elections that occur before the 2024 primary election, through which a vote by mail ballot can be delivered by electronic transmission to voters

- 4 (c) For the November 8, 2022 general election and all
- 5 <u>subsequent elections that occur before the 2024 primary</u>
- 6 election, election Election authorities shall permit voters
- 7 with a print disability to receive and mark their vote by mail
- 8 ballots (i) through the certified remote accessible vote by
- 9 mail system provided by the State Board of Elections pursuant
- 10 to subsection (b) of this Section or (ii) through a certified
- 11 remote accessible vote by mail system provided by the election
- 12 authority.
- 13 (d) If a vote by mail ballot application from a voter with
- 14 a print disability arrives after the jurisdiction begins
- transmitting vote by mail ballots and instructions to voters,
- 16 the election authority shall electronically transmit the
- 17 ballot, instructions, and balloting materials to the voter
- 18 within two business days after receipt of the application.
- 19 (e) Ballots received and marked pursuant to subsections
- 20 (b) and (c) of this Section must be printed by the voter and
- 21 returned to the election authority as provided in Section
- 22 19-6.
- 23 <u>(f) For the 2</u>024 primary election and all subsequent
- 24 <u>elections</u>, the State Board of Elections shall provide a
- 25 certified remote accessible vote by mail system through which
- 26 <u>an election authority can deliver a vote by mail ballot</u>

- 11 authentication.
- (h) All electronic documents and web pages that must be 12
- 13 used as part of the certified remote accessible vote by mail
- 14 system provided by the State Board of Elections or election
- 15 authorities shall be compliant with the Web Content
- Accessibility Guidelines 2.1 Level AA standards and updated as 16
- necessary to comply with any subsequent Web Content 17
- 18 Accessibility Guidelines standards.
- (i) (f) The State Board of Elections shall adopt rules, 19
- 20 including emergency rules, necessary for the implementation of
- this Section. The State Board of Elections' adopted rules 2.1
- shall include certification standards for a remote accessible 22
- 23 vote by mail system and a method subject to the provisions in
- 24 Sections 19-2 and 19-3 of this Article by which a voter with a
- 25 print disability may request to use a certified remote
- 26 accessible vote by mail system and apply for an accessible

- vote by mail ballot.

- 5 system. An election authority shall provide a certified remote
- 6 accessible vote by mail system that complies with Section
- 7 19-2.6, or use the certified remote accessible vote by mail
- 8 system provided by the State Board of Elections under Section
- 9 19-2.6, through which a vote by mail ballot can be delivered by
- 10 electronic transmission to any voter eligible to receive a
- 11 vote by mail ballot under this Article and through which a
- voter can mark, verify, and return a vote by mail ballot to the
- 13 election authority electronically. The certified remote
- 14 accessible vote by mail system shall comply with the
- requirements of Section 19-2.6, except subsection (h) of
- 16 Section 19-2.6.
