1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 950

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend Senate Bill 950 by replacing  
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Director of Corrections, on behalf of the  
5 State of Illinois, is authorized to execute and deliver to the  
6 City of Chester, a municipality organized and existing under  
7 the laws of the State of Illinois, for and in consideration of  
8 \$1 paid to the Department of Corrections, a quit claim deed to  
9 the following described real property, to wit:

10 Beginning at the intersection of the Southwest  
11 right-of-way line of the Union Pacific Railroad and the  
12 East line of Section 15, Township 7 South, Range 7 West;  
13 from said point of beginning; thence South along the East  
14 line of the last aforesaid Section 15 and the Southerly  
15 projection thereof, a distance of 1000.00 feet to a point;  
16 thence Southwest along a line with a deflection angle of

1       45°00' to the right, a distance of 600.00 feet to a point;  
2       thence Northwest along a line with a deflection angle of  
3       65°00' to the right, a distance of 1750.00 feet to a point;  
4       thence Northwest along a line with a deflection angle of  
5       20°00' to the right, a distance of 2100.00 feet to a point;  
6       thence Northeast along a line with a deflection angle of  
7       95°00' to the right, a distance of approximately 2080 feet  
8       to a point in the Southwest right-of-way line of the Union  
9       Pacific Railroad; thence Southeast along the Southwest  
10      right-of-way line of the Union Pacific Railroad, a  
11      distance of approximately 2975 feet to the point of  
12      beginning for this description, containing 154 acre more  
13      or less.

14       Section 10. The conveyances of real property authorized by  
15      Section 5 shall be made subject to: (1) existing public  
16      utilities, existing public roads, and any and all  
17      reservations, easements, encumbrances, covenants, and  
18      restrictions of record; and (2) the express condition that if  
19      said real property ceases to be used for public purposes, it  
20      shall revert to the State of Illinois, Department of  
21      Corrections.

22       Section 15. The Director of Corrections shall obtain a  
23      certified copy of the portions of this Act within 60 days after  
24      its effective date and, upon receipt of the payment required

1 by Section 5, if any payment is required, shall record the  
2 certified document in the Recorder's Office in the county in  
3 which the land is located.

4 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon  
5 becoming law.".
