Amends the Illinois Municipal Code. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning election of incorporated town officers.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning local government.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Illinois Municipal Code is amended by
5 changing Section 3.1-25-95 as follows:

6 (65 ILCS 5/3.1-25-95) (from Ch. 24, par. 3.1-25-95)

7 Sec. 3.1-25-95. Incorporated town officers. For the ~~the~~
8 general municipal election to be held in the year 1985 in every
9 incorporated town with a population of 25,000 or more by the
10 last official census, and every 4 years thereafter, the
11 municipal clerk shall certify the names of the candidates to
12 the proper election authority as provided by the general
13 election law. A president, a clerk, an assessor, a collector,
14 and a supervisor shall be elected for a term of 4 years and
15 until their successors are elected and have qualified.
16 Whenever a vacancy occurs in the office of any of the specified
17 officers, the vacancy shall be filled for the remainder of the
18 term at the next general municipal election in that
19 incorporated town as provided in Section 3.1-10-50. Whenever
20 an election is held for this purpose, the municipal clerk
21 shall certify the office to be filled and the candidates for
22 that office to the election authorities as provided in the
23 general election law. During the period from the time a

1 vacancy occurs until a clerk, assessor, collector, or
2 supervisor is elected and has qualified, the vacancy may be
3 filled by appointment by the president and board of trustees
4 of that incorporated town voting jointly. During the period
5 from the time a vacancy occurs until a president is elected and
6 has qualified, the vacancy may be filled by appointment by the
7 board of trustees of that incorporated town.
