## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Fire Protection District Act is amended by changing Section 16.08b as follows:

- 7 Sec. 16.08b. Emergency medical technician licensure:
- 8 training.
- 9 <u>(a)</u> The board of trustees of a fire protection district
- 10 may require that all firefighters hired on or after January 1,
- 11 2005 (the effective date of Public Act 93-952) by any fire
- 12 department within the district  $\underline{\text{to}}$  must be licensed as an EMT,
- 13 EMT-I, A-EMT, or paramedic under the Emergency Medical
- 14 Services (EMS) Systems Act.
- 15 <u>(b) The board of trustees of a fire protection district</u>
- 16 must, subject to appropriation by the General Assembly,
- 17 reimburse the mandatory training expenses of an EMT, EMT-I,
- 18 A-EMT, or paramedic employed by or under contract with the
- 19 fire protection district, including the training expenses of a
- 20 firefighter required to be licensed as an EMT, EMT-I, A-EMT,
- or paramedic under subsection (a).
