SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

415 ILCS 60/13.10 new

Amends the Illinois Pesticide Act. Provides that no person, other than a pesticide applicator under the direct supervision of a supervisory pesticide applicator, may apply a pesticide within any school building or on the grounds of any school. Exempts emergency application of a pesticide meeting specified requirements from the provisions.

- Section 5. The Illinois Pesticide Act is amended by adding

 Section 13.10 as follows:
- 6 (415 ILCS 60/13.10 new)
- 7 Sec. 13.10. Lawn care pesticides; schools.
- 8 (a) In this Section:
- 9 <u>"Biochemical pesticide" means a naturally occurring</u>
 10 substance that controls pests by nontoxic mechanisms.
- "Integrated pest management" has the same meaning as defined in Section 3.25 of the Structural Pest Control Act.
- "Integrated pest management plan" means a written plan for
 integrated pest management.
- "Lawn care pesticide" means a pesticide registered by the
 United States Environmental Protection Agency and labeled
- pursuant to the federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide
- 18 Act for use in lawn, garden, or ornamental sites or areas.
- 19 <u>"Lawn care pesticide" does not include:</u>
- 20 <u>(1) a microbial pesticide or biochemical pesticide</u>
- 21 <u>that is registered with the United States Environmental</u>
- 22 <u>Protection Agency;</u>
- 23 (2) a horticultural soap or oil that is registered

2	does not contain any synthetic pesticide or synergist; or									
3	(3) a pesticide classified by the United States									
4	Environmental Protection Agency as an exempt material									
5	pursuant to 40 CFR 152.25.									
6	"Microbial pesticide" means a pesticide with a									
7	microorganism as the active ingredient.									
8	(b) No person, other than a pesticide applicator under the									
9	direct supervision of a supervisory pesticide applicator, may									
10	apply a pesticide within any school building or on the grounds									
11	of any school. This subsection shall not apply in the case of									
12	an emergency application of a pesticide to eliminate an									
13	immediate threat to human health where it is impractical to									
14	obtain the services of a pesticide applicator, provided that									
15	the emergency application does not involve a restricted use									
16	pesticide.									
17	(c) No person shall apply a lawn care pesticide on the									
18	grounds of any school with students in grade eight or lower,									
19	<pre>except that:</pre>									
20	(1) until July 1, 2025, a lawn care pesticide may be									
21	applied at a school on the playing fields and playgrounds									
22	of the school pursuant to an integrated pest management									
23	plan; and									
24	(2) notwithstanding Section 3, an emergency									
25	application of a lawn care pesticide may be made if the									
26	school's local health department, the Department of Public
