1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 1779 2 AMENDMENT NO. . Amend Senate Bill 1779, AS AMENDED, 3 with reference to page and line numbers of House Amendment No. 4 1, on page 7, line 13, before "Violations", by inserting "The 5 Department may take disciplinary action against a medication aide, including, but not limited to, suspension or revocation 6 of the medication aide's certification, for gross 8 negligence."; and on page 7, immediately below line 19, by inserting the 9 10 following: 11 "(u) To ensure transparency and the well-being of residents, a facility is required to provide information about 12 medication administration via certified medication aides in 13 14 its admission agreements so that residents and their families understand the addition of certified medication aides as 15 16 members of the healthcare team."; and

- on page 7, line 20, by replacing (u) with (v); and
- on page 7, line 21, by replacing "90" with "180". 2
