2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 1779, AS AMENDED,
3 with reference to page and line numbers of House Amendment No.
4 1, on page 7, line 13, before "Violations", by inserting "The
5 Department may take disciplinary action against a medication
6 aide, including, but not limited to, suspension or revocation
7 of the medication aide's certification, for gross
8 negligence."; and

9 on page 7, immediately below line 19, by inserting the
10 following:

11 "(u) To ensure transparency and the well-being of
12 residents, a facility is required to provide information about
13 medication administration via certified medication aides in
14 its admission agreements so that residents and their families
15 understand the addition of certified medication aides as
16 members of the healthcare team."; and

1 on page 7, line 20, by replacing "u" with "v"; and

2 on page 7, line 21, by replacing "90" with "180".
