SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Appropriates \$125,000,000 from the Fund the Police Grant Fund to the Illinois Law Enforcement Training Standards Board for specified grants to units of local government for all expenses related to the administration of the statutory provisions of the Fund the Police Act. Effective July 1, 2023.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The sum of \$125,000,000, or so much thereof as
5 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fund the Police
6 Grant Fund to the Illinois Law Enforcement Training Standards
7 Board for grants to units of local government for all expenses
8 related to the administration of the statutory provisions of
9 the Fund the Police Act, in the approximate amounts below:

10 For body camera mandates, including the
11 purchase, storage, and other necessary expenses
12 associated with running local body camera programs,
13 and for the purchase of other law enforcement
14 equipment\$42,000,000

15 For additional law enforcement training
16 mandated by State law15,000,000

17 For Mobile Team In-Service Training Units
18 throughout the State5,000,000

19 For hiring, rehiring, and retention of law

1 enforcement officers, including hiring and
2 retention incentives and overtime37,000,000

3 To assist with outreach and community
4 policing activities5,000,000

5 To assist with mental health treatment
6 for individuals in county jails21,000,000

7 Total\$125,000,000

8 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
9 2023.
