SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

70 ILCS 2105/6

from Ch. 42, par. 388

Amends the River Conservancy Districts Act. Provides that the board of a river conservancy district shall annually set the member compensation to be paid solely out of the funds of the district (rather than a member of the board may not receive more than \$3,000 per annum).

AN ACT concerning local government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The River Conservancy Districts Act is amended
 by changing Section 6 as follows:
- 6 (70 ILCS 2105/6) (from Ch. 42, par. 388)

7 Sec. 6. The board of trustees shall exercise all of the powers and control the affairs and property of the district. 8 9 The board at their first meeting in May of each year shall elect one of their number as president, one of their number as 10 vice-president and one of their number as secretary. The board 11 12 engineer who may be an individual, may appoint an 13 co-partnership or corporation, an attorney, an executive 14 vice-president, a manager, a treasurer, and other engineers, attorneys, agents, clerks and assistants for the district who 15 16 shall hold office during the pleasure of the board and who 17 shall give such bond as the board may require. The board may prescribe the duties and fix the compensation of all the 18 19 officers and employees of the district. Annually the board 20 will set the member compensation to be paid solely out of the 21 funds of the district. A member of the board may not receive 22 more than \$3,000 per annum. The board may pass all necessary ordinances, rules and regulations. 23
