SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/3-699.23 new

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Allows the Secretary of State to issue special registration plates designated as Sons of the American Legion plates to residents of this State who meet the eligibility requirements prescribed by the Secretary of State. Provides that the plates shall display the Sons of the American Legion logo. Provides that in all other respects, the design, color, and format of the plates shall be within the discretion of the Secretary of State.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by adding
Section 3-699.23 as follows:

6 (625 ILCS 5/3-699.23 new)

7 Sec. 3-699.23. Sons of the American Legion plates.

(a) In addition to any other special license plate, the 8 9 Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and applications made in the form prescribed by the Secretary, may 10 issue Sons of the American Legion plates to residents of 11 12 Illinois who meet eligibility requirements prescribed by the Secretary. The special plate issued under this Section shall 13 14 be affixed only to passenger vehicles of the first division, motorcycles, and motor vehicles of the second division 15 weighing not more than 8,000 pounds. Plates issued under this 16 Section shall expire according to the staggered multi-year 17 procedure established by Section 3-414.1 of this Code. 18

19 (b) The plates shall display the Sons of the American 20 Legion logo. In all other respects, the design, color, and 21 format of the plates shall be within the discretion of the 22 Secretary. The Secretary may, in his or her discretion, allow 23 the plates to be issued as vanity plates or personalized
