9 (a) Informational guide. On and after July 1, 2025, the Department of Healthcare and Family Services shall develop, 10 post, and maintain on its official website a comprehensive 11 12 informational guide that explains the Medicaid 5-year look-back period as it applies to eligibility for long-term 13 14 care coverage under the medical assistance program established under Article V of this Code. The contents of the 15 16 informational guide must include the following:

17 <u>(1) Overview of the Medicaid 5-year look-back period:</u>
18 <u>A detailed explanation of the 5-year look-back period,</u>
19 <u>including its purpose and relevance to eligibility for</u>
20 <u>medical assistance.</u>

21 (2) Eligibility criteria affected by the Medicaid
 22 5-year look-back period: Clear information on how the
 23 5-year look-back period affects eligibility criteria,

including income and asset requirements. 1 2 (3) Calculation of the Medicaid 5-year look-back 3 period: Step-by-step guidance on how the 5-year look-back period is calculated, including the start date and end 4 5 date considerations. 6 (4) Examples and scenarios: Real-life examples and scenarios illustrating how the 5-year look-back period 7 applies in different situations, providing practical 8 9 insights for the public. The guide must include a 10 calculator that allows a user to enter the transfer dates 11 and monetary value of any assets the user transferred during the 5-year look back period in order to estimate 12 the earliest date upon which the user may qualify for 13 14 medical assistance for long-term care services. (5) Transfers or gifts during the Medicaid 5-year 15 16 look-back period: Explanation of the consequences and

17 <u>implications of transfers or gifts made during the 5-year</u>
18 <u>look-back period, emphasizing the impact on eligibility</u>
19 <u>and potential penalties.</u>

20 (6) Exceptions and exemptions: Information on
 21 exceptions and exemptions to the 5-year look-back period,
 22 clarifying circumstances where certain transfers or assets
 23 may not be subject to scrutiny.

24 (7) Documentation requirements: Guidance on the
 25 documentation individuals may need to provide or maintain
 26 to demonstrate compliance with the 5-year look-back

2	(8) Planning for eligibility: Tips and considerations
3	for individuals and families on how to plan for
4	eligibility for medical assistance under Article V of this
5	Code, taking into account the 5-year look-back period.
6	(9) Appeals and dispute resolution: Information on the
7	process for appeals and dispute resolution related to
8	decisions made based on the 5-year look-back period.
9	(10) Contact information and resources: Clear and
10	accessible contact information for the Department of
11	Healthcare and Family Services, as well as a listing of
12	additional resources or agencies that individuals can
13	reach out to for assistance or further clarification.
14	(11) Frequently asked questions: A "Frequently Asked
15	Questions" section that lists common questions and
16	concerns related to the 5-year look-back period and
17	provides a quick reference for users.
18	(b) Accessibility of the guide. To ensure user-friendly
19	navigation and visibility, the Department of Healthcare and
20	Family Services shall post on its official website detailed
21	information on how users can easily access the comprehensive
22	guide on the website and a hyperlink that directs users to the
23	comprehensive guide.
