1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 3686

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 3686 on page 2,
3 immediately below line 11, by inserting the following:

4 "Agency-sponsored household battery recycling program"
5 means a household battery recycling program sponsored by the
6 Agency where the Agency provides for the transport,
7 processing, recycling, and other end-of-life management for
8 household-generated batteries collected by Agency collection
9 partners under grant funding provided by the U.S. Department
10 of Energy on or after January 1, 2024."; and

11 on page 2, immediately below line 22, by inserting the
12 following:

13 "Battery Stewardship Program" means a program implemented
14 by a battery stewardship organization consistent with an
15 approved battery stewardship plan."; and

16 on page 3, line 20, by deleting "and"; and

1 on page 3, line 23, by replacing "product." with "product;
2 and"; and

3 on page 3, immediately below line 23, by inserting the
4 following:

5 "(6) a battery that is a component of a motor vehicle
6 or intended for use exclusively in motor vehicles."; and

7 on page 4, immediately below line 8, by inserting the
8 following:

9 "'Motor vehicle" includes automobiles, vans, trucks,
10 tractors, motorcycles, and motorboats as defined in subsection
11 (h) of Section 22.23 of the Environmental Protection Act. For
12 purposes of this Act, "motor vehicle" also includes
13 all-terrain vehicles as defined in Section 1-101.8 of the
14 Illinois Vehicle Code and watercraft as defined in Section 1-2
15 of the Boat Registration and Safety Act."; and

16 on page 7, by deleting lines 21 through 23; and

17 on page 13, line 14, after "sites", by inserting "supported by
18 the battery stewardship program"; and

19 on page 13, line 15, after "sites", by inserting "supported by
20 the battery stewardship program"; and

1 on page 15, line 10, by replacing "plan", with "plan, or the
2 addition or removal of a collection location to the battery
3 stewardship program because of changes to an Agency-sponsored
4 household battery recycling program"; and

5 on page 22, immediately below line 2, by inserting the
6 following:

7 "(4) The collection location requirements set forth in
8 paragraphs (2) and (3) of this subsection may be satisfied by
9 collection locations participating in an Agency-sponsored
10 household battery recycling program."; and

11 on page 22, lines 5 through 7, by replacing "December 31, 2026
12 for portable batteries and by no later than December 31, 2028
13 for medium-format batteries" with "December 31, 2028"; and

14 on page 39, immediately below line 2, by inserting the
15 following:

16 "Section 95. Agency-sponsored household battery recycling
17 program. If the Agency receives funding to support an
18 Agency-sponsored household battery recycling program that
19 operates concurrently with the Battery Stewardship Program
20 that is the subject of this Act, the costs of collecting and
21 managing batteries through the Agency-sponsored household

1 battery recycling program shall not be the responsibility of
2 the battery stewardship organization.".
