1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 3768 2 AMENDMENT NO. . Amend Senate Bill 3768 as follows: 3 by replacing line 12 on page 1 through line 4 on page 2 with the following: 4 5 "(a) For the purpose of this Section, persons with deaf-blindness are (i) individuals with concomitant hearing 6 and visual impairments, the combination of which causes such 7 severe communication and other developmental and educational 8 needs that they cannot be accommodated in special education 9 programs solely for children with deafness or children with 10 11 blindness, (ii) individuals with solely a hearing impairment, or (iii) individuals with solely a visual impairment. persons 12 13 who have both auditory and visual impairments, the combination of which causes such severe communication and other 14 developmental, educational, vocational and rehabilitation 15 16 problems that such persons cannot be properly accommodated in

special education or vocational rehabilitation programs solely

- (b) To be eligible for deaf-blind services under this Section, a person must have (i) a visual impairment, a hearing and an auditory impairment, or both or (ii) a condition in which there is a progressive loss of hearing, or vision, or both that results in concomitant vision and hearing impairments and that adversely affects educational performance as determined by the multidisciplinary conference. For purposes of this paragraph and Section:"; and
- on page 2, line 15, by replacing "An auditory" with "A hearing

  An auditory"; and
- on page 3, lines 7 through 9, by deleting "The Philip J. Rock

  Center and School shall be located in the Chicago metropolitan

  area near public transportation."; and
- on page 4, by replacing lines 6 through 8 with the following:
- 16 "(6) <u>maintaining</u> <u>Maintaining</u> a

  17 residential-educational training facility <u>with or without</u>

  18 <u>a day program</u> in the Chicago metropolitan area located

  19 near <u>in an area accessible to public transportation;</u>; and
- on page 4, by replacing lines 23 through 25 with the following:
- 21 "(11) <u>serving</u> as the <u>information</u> <del>referral</del> 22 clearinghouse for all persons who are deaf-blind, age 21
