8 six billion slices of bacon per year, and the average American

11 high-quality product deserve our support; whether its plain or
12 apple-wood smoked, whether store-bought or artisan-made, bacon
13 is a meat for any meal; and

14 WHEREAS, The phrase "Bacon Never Broke My Heart" goes

16 WHEREAS, National Bacon Day is celebrated in December, but
17 Illinois needs its own day to pay tribute to this decadent,
18 rich, and indulgent meat; therefore, be it
