WHEREAS, Zack Defreitas was employed as Director of Marketing and Communications for the Springfield Jr. Blues, where he worked since 2018; he also served as the play-by-play announcer for the Springfield Jr. Blues and became popular with the team's fan base; he formerly served as the broadcaster for the Springfield Sliders baseball team in the summer of 2021; and
