12	WHEREAS, Lela Tyler attended Pilgrim Rest M.B. Church,
13	where she faithfully served as an usher, a Finance Room
14	helper, and a deaconess; she also assisted the Sunday school;

18	Baptist Association (UDBA), where she was known for her
