11	assistant, and later, received an Honorary Doctor of Divinity
12	from Midwest Bible College; and

15	before working in ministry and assuming the office of pastor;

19	Keeper Community Resource Center and the IPAE Network, Faith

2 hospitality, and had a great sense of humor; she was always
3 proud of her children's accomplishments; she was soft spoken
4 and reserved unless preaching, where she displayed a bold and
5 explosive passion; and

WHEREAS, Rose McCoy led a life of honorable service, punctuated by selfless dedication, unwavering devotion, and unconditional love; she wore many hats, literally and figuratively, and profoundly touched the lives of many in manifold ways through her service, her resources, and her example; and

WHEREAS, Rose McCoy was preceded in death by her parents; her daughter, Billie McCoy-Thomas; and her siblings, Ida Belle Evans, Gloria Glass, Ernestine Evans, and Stanley Evans; and
