## SENATE RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois Senate are saddened to learn of the death of John D. "Jack" McDermott of Chatham, who passed away on July 20, 2018; and

WHEREAS, Jack McDermott was born to George and Elizabeth (Darrah) McDermott in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania on May 8, 1936; he attended Immaculate Conception Catholic Grade School and Northeast Catholic High School in Philadelphia; he earned a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration from La Salle College in Philadelphia, where he served as secretary, treasurer, vice-president, and president of the La Salle College Evening Division-Student Congress and was a member of Cross Keys Student Service Fraternity; he enlisted in the U.S. Army in 1956, serving as a helicopter mechanic in Korea before being honorably discharged in 1962; he married Mary S. Killeen at the Immaculate Conception Catholic Church in Philadelphia on September 27, 1958; and

WHEREAS, Jack McDermott took care of his family by working multiple jobs at a time, including driving a chicken delivery car at night; he was employed with Standard Pressed Steel, 3M, and Morton Salt in Pennsylvania; while employed with the DICKEY-john Corporation, he moved his family to Illinois, and he went on to work with Meyer Snow Plow; over the years, he
