- 2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois Senate are saddened 3 to learn of the death of David N. Anderson, who passed away on 4 July 6, 2023; and
- 5 WHEREAS, David Anderson was born to Silas and Annette 6 Anderson in Harrisburg on July 19, 1946; he graduated from 7 Harrisburg High School in 1964; he married Elizabeth in 8 Decatur on March 15, 1969; and
  - WHEREAS, David Anderson worked in radio for ten years during the 1960s and early 1970s, spending the first two years with his hometown station WEBQ, followed by joining WGGH in nearby Marion while attending Southern Illinois University Carbondale, and then working at WDZ in Decatur; his final position in radio was a stint as news director of Springfield's WDBR and WTAX while pursuing a master's degree in communications at Sangamon State University, known today as the University of Illinois Springfield; and
  - WHEREAS, David Anderson was hired as director of public affairs for the Illinois State Bar Association in 1974, and he maintained that title for 39 years until his retirement; during his tenure, he also served in a variety of other posts, including associate executive director; and
