WHEREAS, Kenneth Manning was born to Lyle T. and Lois I. Childress Manning in Shelbyville on August 18, 1932; he graduated from Shelbyville High School in 1951; he attended Brown's Business School in Springfield; he married Roxy Jane Anderson in Petersburg on October 2, 1952; he served in the U.S. Air Force from 1952 to 1956, where he was stationed in Saudi Arabia during the Korean War; and

WHEREAS, Kenneth Manning worked for Marine Bank for 25 years, most recently as assistant vice president; during his tenure, he also served on the financial institution's bowling team; and

WHEREAS, Kenneth Manning belonged to several professional organizations; he was a member of the Central Illinois Credit Association, serving as president from 1982 to 1983, and a 30-year member of the Consumer Credit Association, serving as president in 1988; and
