5 WHEREAS, Betty Maguire, the daughter of Harold and Mary 6 (Eater) Qualls, was born in Carlinville on October 14, 1940; 7 she graduated from Virden High School in 1958; she married 8 Richard "Dick" Maguire in Virden on September 27, 1959; and

9 WHEREAS, Betty Maguire worked for Horace Mann and the 10 offices of the Macoupin County State's Attorney, the State's 11 Attorney Appellate Prosecutor, the Sangamon County State's 12 Attorney, and the Governor; and

WHEREAS, Betty Maguire was dedicated to serving her community, beginning when she joined the Virden School Board in the late 1970s; she served as an alderperson for Ward 3 of Virden for numerous years, and she often served as an election judge at the polls; she also served on the Virden Park Board and the Virden Queen Pageant and as a judge in cheerleading competitions at Virden Middle School, now North Mac Middle School; and
