- 4 on October 1, 2024; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Tom Roger was born to Edward and Mary (Boehle)
- 6 Roger in Peoria on February 17, 1942; he attended Mid County
- 7 Schools, graduating in 1960; he served in the U.S. Army from
- 8 1964 to 1966, during which he was stationed in Vietnam from
- 9 1965 to 1966; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Tom Roger worked for the Marshall County Highway
- Department for 42 years, retiring in 2004; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Tom Roger was a founding member of the
- 13 Chillicothe Recreational Area, and he was also a member of the
- 14 Peoria Barbershop Society Chorus; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Tom Roger helped start the Lacon Merchants
- 16 fast-pitch softball team in the 1970s, leading the team
- 17 through many names, including the Lacon Merchants, Blarney
- 18 Castle, and the Lacon Bombers, before finally merging with Two
- 19 Brothers Tap; and
- 20 WHEREAS, Tom Roger enjoyed snowmobiling, and he was a fan

of the Green Bay Packers and the University of Illinois; and
