AN ACT concerning education.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The School Code is amended by changing
5 Section 27-21 as follows:

7 Sec. 27-21. History of United States.

8 (a) History of the United States shall be taught in all public schools and in all other educational institutions in 9 this State supported or maintained, in whole or in part, by 10 public funds. The teaching of history shall have as one of 11 its objectives the imparting to pupils of a comprehensive 12 13 idea of our democratic form of government and the principles for which our government stands as regards other nations, 14 15 including the studying of the place of our government in 16 world-wide movements and the leaders thereof, with particular stress upon the basic principles and 17 ideals of our 18 representative form of government. The teaching of history 19 shall include a study of the role and contributions of 20 African Americans and other ethnic groups including but not restricted to Polish, Lithuanian, German, Hungarian, Irish, 21 22 Bohemian, Russian, Albanian, Italian, Czech, Slovak, French, Scots, Hispanics, etc., in the history of this country and 23 this State. The teaching of history also shall include a 24 study of the role of labor unions and their interaction with 25 26 government in achieving the goals of a mixed free enterprise 27 system. No pupils shall be graduated from the eighth grade of any public school unless he has received such instruction 28 in the history of the United States and gives evidence of 29 30 having a comprehensive knowledge thereof.

5 Section 90. The State Mandates Act is amended by adding
6 Section 8.27 as follows:

8 Sec. 8.27. Exempt mandate. Notwithstanding Sections 6 9 and 8 of this Act, no reimbursement by the State is required 10 for the implementation of any mandate created by this 11 amendatory Act of the 93rd General Assembly.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect on July 1, 2003.
