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AN ACT in regard to vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by
changing Section 3-806.3 as follows:

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(625 ILCS 5/3-806.3) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 3-806.3) Sec. 3-806.3. Senior Citizens.

8 Commencing with the 2001 registration year and extending through the 2003 registration year, the registration fee paid 9 by any vehicle owner who has claimed and received a grant 10 under the Senior Citizens and Disabled Persons Property Tax 11 Relief and Pharmaceutical Assistance Act or who is the spouse 12 13 of such a person shall be \$24 instead of the fee otherwise provided in this Code for passenger cars displaying standard 14 15 multi-year registration plates issued under Section 3-414.1, 16 motor vehicles displaying special registration plates issued under Section 3-616, motor vehicles registered at 8,000 17 pounds or less under Section 3-815(a) and recreational 18 vehicles registered at 8,000 pounds or less under Section 19 20 3-815(b). Widows and widowers of claimants shall also be entitled to this reduced registration 21 fee for the 22 registration year in which the claimant was eligible.

During Commencing--with the 2004 registration year, the 23 registration fee paid by any vehicle owner who has claimed 24 and received a grant under the Senior Citizens and Disabled 25 Persons Property Tax Relief and Pharmaceutical Assistance Act 26 27 or who is the spouse of such a person shall be \$24 instead of the fee otherwise provided in this Code for passenger cars 28 29 displaying standard multi-year registration plates issued under Section 3-414.1, motor vehicles displaying special 30 registration plates issued under Section 3-616, 3-621, 3-622, 31

3-623, 3-624, 3-625, 3-626, 3-628, 3-638, 3-642, 3-645,
3-647, 3-650, or 3-651, motor vehicles registered at 8,000
pounds or less under Section 3-815(a), and recreational
vehicles registered at 8,000 pounds or less under Section
3-815(b). Widows and widowers of claimants shall also be
entitled to this reduced registration fee for the
registration year in which the claimant was eligible.

Commencing with the 2004 registration year, the 8 9 registration fee paid by any vehicle owner who is eligible 10 for a grant under the Senior Citizens and Disabled Persons 11 Property Tax Relief and Pharmaceutical Assistance Act or who 12 is the spouse of an eligible person shall be \$24 instead of the fee otherwise provided in this Code for passenger cars 13 displaying standard multi-year registration plates issued 14 under Section 3-414.1, motor vehicles displaying special 15 registration plates issued under Section 3-616, motor 16 vehicles registered at 8,000 pounds or less under Section 17 3-815(a), and recreational vehicles registered at 8,000 18 19 pounds or less under Section 3-815(b). Widows and widowers of eligible persons are also entitled to this reduced 20 registration fee for the registration year in which the 21 22 person was eligible.

23 No more than one reduced registration fee under this Section shall be allowed during any 12 month period based on 24 25 the primary eligibility of any individual, whether such reduced registration fee is allowed to the individual or to 26 the spouse, widow or widower of such individual. This 27 Section does not apply to the fee paid in addition to the 28 registration fee for motor vehicles displaying vanity or 29 30 special license plates.
