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AN ACT in relation to vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by
changing Section 6-106 as follows:

6 (625 ILCS 5/6-106) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 6-106)
7 Sec. 6-106. Application for license or instruction
8 permit.

(a) Every application for any permit 9 or license authorized to be issued under this Act shall be made upon a 10 form furnished by the Secretary of State. Every application 11 shall be accompanied by the proper fee and payment of such 12 13 fee shall entitle the applicant to not more than 3 attempts to pass the examination within a period of 1 year after the 14 15 date of application.

(b) Every application shall state the name, social 16 security number, zip code, date of birth, sex, and residence 17 address of the applicant; briefly describe the applicant; 18 state whether the applicant has theretofore been licensed as 19 20 a driver, and, if so, when and by what state or country, and whether any such license has ever been cancelled, suspended, 21 22 revoked or refused, and, if so, the date and reason for such cancellation, suspension, revocation or refusal; 23 shall include an affirmation by the applicant that all information 24 set forth is true and correct; and shall bear the applicant's 25 26 signature. The application form may also require the statement of such additional relevant information as the 27 Secretary of State shall deem necessary to determine the 28 29 applicant's competency and eligibility. The Secretary of State may in his discretion substitute a federal tax number 30 in lieu of a social security number, or he may instead assign 31

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1 an additional distinctive number in lieu thereof, where an 2 applicant is prohibited by bona fide religious convictions from applying or is exempt from applying for a social 3 4 security number. The Secretary of State shall, however, 5 determine which religious orders or sects have such bona fide б religious convictions. The Secretary of State may, in his or 7 her discretion, by rule, provide that an application for a drivers permit may include a suitable photograph of the 8 9 applicant in the form prescribed by the Secretary. The Secretary of State shall may, -in-his-discretion, by rule or 10 11 regulation, provide that an application for a drivers license must or-permit-may include a suitable photograph of the 12 applicant in the form prescribed by the Secretary, and he or 13 she shall may further provide that each drivers license shall 14 15 include a photograph of the driver. The Secretary of State 16 shall may utilize a photograph process or system most suitable to deter alteration or improper reproduction of a 17 drivers license and to prevent substitution of another photo 18 19 thereon.

(c) The application form shall include a notice to the applicant of the registration obligations of sex offenders under the Sex Offender Registration Act. The notice shall be provided in a form and manner prescribed by the Secretary of State. For purposes of this subsection (c), "sex offender" has the meaning ascribed to it in Section 2 of the Sex Offender Registration Act.

Any male United States citizen or 27 immigrant who (d) for any permit or license authorized to be issued 28 applies 29 under this Act or for a renewal of any permit or license, and 30 who is at least 18 years of age but less than 26 years of age, must be registered in compliance with the requirements 31 32 of the federal Military Selective Service Act. The Secretary of State must forward in an electronic format the necessary 33 34 personal information regarding the applicants identified in

this subsection (d) to the Selective Service System. The 1 applicant's signature on the application serves as an 2 indication that the applicant either has already registered 3 4 with the Selective Service System or that he is authorizing the Secretary to forward to the Selective Service System the 5 necessary information for registration. The Secretary must 6 7 notify the applicant at the time of application that his signature constitutes consent to registration with the 8 Selective Service System, if he is not already registered. 9 (Source: P.A. 92-117, eff. 1-1-02.) 10
