- Sec. 6-127.5. Alternative payment option.
- 8 (a) This Section applies only to a fireman who (i) has
- 9 <u>at least 23 years of creditable service, (ii) has attained</u>
- 10 age 50, and (iii) withdraws from service on or after the
- 11 <u>effective date of this Section.</u>
- 12 (b) A qualifying fireman may elect, at the time of
- 13 applying for an age and service annuity under this Article,
- 14 to receive a lump sum payment at the time of retirement, in
- 15 <u>exchange for which he or she agrees to forfeit one, 2, or 3</u>
- 16 years of service credit. The lump sum payment shall be an
