AN ACT concerning the Metropolitan Water Reclamation
 District.

3 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,4 represented in the General Assembly:

5 Section 5. The Metropolitan Water Reclamation District
6 Act is amended by changing Section 5.9 as follows:

7 (70 ILCS 2605/5.9) (from Ch. 42, par. 324s)

8 Sec. 5.9. The board of trustees shall, at any time after March 1 of each fiscal year, have power, by a two-thirds vote 9 all the members of such body, to authorize the making of 10 of transfers within a department or between departments of sums 11 of money appropriated for one corporate object or function to 12 13 another corporate object or function. Any such action by the board of trustees shall be entered in the proceedings of the 14 board. No appropriation for any object or function shall be 15 16 reduced below an amount sufficient to cover all unliquidated and outstanding contracts or obligations certified from or 17 18 against the appropriation for such purpose.

19 The board of trustees, by a two-thirds vote of all its 20 members, may transfer the interest earned on any moneys of the district into the district's fund or funds that are most 21 22 in need of the interest income. This authority does not apply to any interest that has been earmarked or restricted 23 by the board for a designated purpose. This authority does 24 not apply to any interest earned on any funds for purposes of 25 the Metropolitan Water Reclamation District Retirement Fund 26 27 or Reserve Claim Fund.

28 <u>The board of trustees, by a two-thirds vote of all its</u> 29 <u>members, may transfer fund balances between its Working Cash</u> 30 <u>Funds.</u>
