- 1 AN ACT concerning transportation.
- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Department of Transportation Law of the
- 5 Civil Administrative Code of Illinois is amended by adding
- 6 Section 2705-207 as follows:
- 7 (20 ILCS 2705/2705-207 new)
- 8 <u>Sec. 2705-207. Regional Transportation Task Force.</u>
- 9 <u>(a) The Regional Transportation Task Force is created</u>
- 10 <u>within the Department</u>.
- 11 (b) The Task Force shall consist of 11 voting members,
- 12 <u>as follows: 3 members appointed by the Governor, one of whom</u>
- shall be designated as chair of the task force at the time of
- 14 <u>appointment; 2 members appointed by the President of the</u>
- Senate; 2 members appointed by the Senate Minority Leader; 2
- 16 members appointed by the Speaker of the House of
- 17 Representatives; and 2 members appointed by the House
- 18 <u>Minority Leader</u>.
- 19 <u>The following shall serve, ex officio, as non-voting</u>
- 20 members: the Secretary of Transportation; one member
- 21 <u>designated</u> by the Chicago Area Transportation Study (CATS);
- 22 <u>one member designated by the Northeastern Illinois Planning</u>
- 23 <u>Commission (NIPC); one member designated by the Regional</u>
- 24 <u>Transportation Authority (RTA); and one member designated by</u>
- 25 <u>the Illinois State Toll Highway Authority (ISTHA).</u>
- 26 <u>If a vacancy occurs in the task force membership, the</u>
- 27 <u>vacancy shall be filled in the same manner as the initial</u>
- 28 <u>appointment</u>.
- 29 (c) The task force may begin to conduct business upon
- 30 the appointment of a majority of the voting members,

- 1 <u>including the chair.</u>
- 2 (d) The task force may adopt bylaws; it must meet at
- 3 <u>least once each calendar quarter; and it may establish</u>
- 4 <u>committees</u> and <u>officers</u> as it deems necessary. For purposes
- 5 <u>of task force meetings, a quorum is 6 voting members.</u>
- 6 Meetings of the task force are subject to the Open Meetings
- 7 Act. The task force must afford an opportunity for public
- 8 <u>comment at each of its meetings.</u>
- 9 <u>(e) Task force members shall serve without compensation,</u>
- 10 <u>but may be reimbursed for their reasonable travel expenses</u>
- from funds available for that purpose. The Department shall
- 12 provide staff and administrative support services to the task
- 13 <u>force</u>.
- 14 (f) The task force shall gather information and make
- 15 <u>recommendations to the Governor and to the General Assembly</u>
- 16 regarding metro area transportation programs in northeastern
- 17 <u>Illinois, including but not limited to:</u>
- 18 <u>(1) examining the feasibility of merging CATS,</u>
- NIPC, RTA, and ISTHA into a single agency;
- 20 (2) identifying areas where functions of these and
- other agencies are redundant or unnecessary; and
- 22 <u>(3) identifying methods to promote</u>
- 23 <u>cost-effectiveness and efficiency in meeting area</u>
- 24 <u>transportation needs.</u>
- 25 (g) The task force shall submit a report to the Governor
- 26 and the General Assembly by November 1, 2004 concerning its
- 27 <u>findings and recommendations.</u>
- 28 (h) This Section is repealed on January 1, 2005.
- 29 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 30 becoming law.
