- 1 AN ACT concerning legislative member initiatives.
- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The State Finance Act is amended by adding
- 5 Section 13.5 as follows:
- 6 (30 ILCS 105/13.5 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 13.5. Limitation on appropriations for legislative</u>
- 8 member initiatives.
- 9 (a) Unless it complies with this Section, a purported
- 10 <u>appropriation</u> of <u>State funds</u> for a <u>legislative member</u>
- 11 <u>initiative is not a valid appropriation. No State funds may</u>
- 12 <u>be expended for a legislative member initiative unless the</u>
- 13 <u>appropriation for that legislative member initiative complies</u>
- with this Section.
- 15 (b) Each appropriation for a legislative member
- 16 <u>initiative must be by a separate line item appropriation.</u>
- 17 That line item must fully describe the legislative member
- 18 <u>initiative</u>, including without limitation the entity that will
- 19 <u>receive the benefit of the expenditure, the purpose of the</u>
- 20 <u>expenditure</u>, the specific location of the project, and the
- 21 <u>Legislative District and Representative District in which the</u>
- 22 project is located. No legislative member initiative may be
- funded through a lump sum appropriation.
- 24 (c) "Legislative member initiative" means an
- 25 appropriation for a grant or distribution to a specific unit
- 26 <u>of local government, specific school district, specific</u>
- 27 <u>not-for-profit organization</u>, <u>or specific non-governmental</u>
- 28 <u>entity for infrastructure improvements or operating expenses.</u>
- 29 Appropriations that are part of a statewide program and are
- 30 <u>based on generally applicable standards of eligibility are</u>
- 31 <u>not legislative member initiatives. "Infrastructure</u>

- 1 <u>improvements" include without limitation capital</u>
- 2 improvements, capital projects, planning, construction,
- 3 reconstruction, equipment, utilities, vehicles, and all costs
- 4 <u>associated with economic development, community programs,</u>
- 5 <u>educational programs, public health, and public safety.</u>
- 6 (d) The purpose of this Section is to require full and
- 7 <u>complete disclosure during the appropriation process of State</u>
- 8 <u>expenditures that are primarily for a specific local</u>
- 9 <u>community within a Legislative District or Representative</u>
- 10 <u>District</u>. This <u>Section</u> shall be liberally construed to
- 11 <u>effectuate its purpose.</u>
- 12 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 13 becoming law.
