- 1 AN ACT in relation to housing.
- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The State Housing Act is amended by changing
- 5 Section 2 as follows:
- 6 (310 ILCS 5/2) (from Ch. 67 1/2, par. 152)
- 7 Sec. 2. <u>Purpose</u>. It is hereby declared that congested
- 8 and unsanitary housing conditions which exist in certain
- 9 areas of the state in low-priced dwellings are a menace to
- 10 the health, safety, morals, welfare and reasonable comfort of
- 11 the citizens of the state. The correction of these conditions
- in such areas being now otherwise impossible, it is essential
- 13 that provision be made to encourage the investment of funds
- 14 at low interest rates, the acquisition at fair prices of
- 15 adequate parcels of land, the gradual demolition of existing
- 16 unsanitary and unsafe housing and the construction of new
- 17 housing facilities under public supervision, with proper
- 18 standards of sanitation and safety, and at a cost which will
- 19 permit monthly rentals or charges which wage-earners can
- 20 afford to pay, and not in excess of the rates hereinafter
- 21 provided.
- Therefore, there are created and authorized the agencies
- 23 and instrumentalities hereinafter prescribed, which are
- 24 declared to be the agencies and instrumentalities of the
- 25 state for the purpose of attaining the ends herein recited.
