- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Exotic Weed Act is amended by
- 5 changing Section 3 as follows:
- 6 (525 ILCS 10/3) (from Ch. 5, par. 933)
- 7 Sec. 3. Designated Exotic Weeds. Japanese honeysuckle
- 8 (Lonicera japonica), multiflora rose (Rosa multiflora), and
- 9 purple loosestrife (Lythrum salicaria), common buckthorn
- 10 (Rhamnus cathartica), glossy buckthorn (Rhamnus frangula),
- 11 <u>saw-toothed buckthorn (Rhamnus arguta)</u>, <u>dahurian buckthorn</u>
- 12 (Rhamnus davurica), Japanese buckthorn (Rhamnus japonica),
- 13 <u>Chinese buckthorn (Rhamnus utilis), and kudzu (Pueraria</u>
- 14 <u>lobata</u>) are hereby designated exotic weeds. Upon petition
- 15 the Director of Natural Resources, by rule, shall exempt
- 16 varieties of any species listed in this Act that can be
- 17 demonstrated by published or current research not to be an
- 18 exotic weed as defined in Section 2.
