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AN ACT in relation to insurance.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Children's Health Insurance Program Act
is amended by changing Section 5 as follows:

7 (Section scheduled to be repealed on July 1, 2003)

8 Sec. 5. Legislative intent. The General Assembly finds that, for the economic and social benefit of all citizens of 9 the State of Illinois, it is important to enable low-income 10 children of this State, to the extent funding permits, to 11 access health benefits coverage, especially preventive health 12 13 care. The General Assembly recognizes that assistance to help families purchase health benefits for low-income 14 children must be provided in a fair and equitable fashion and 15 16 must treat all children at the same income level in a similar fashion. The State of Illinois should help low-income 17 families transition from a health care system where 18 government partners with families to provide health benefits 19 20 to low-income children to a system where families with higher incomes eventually transition into private or employer based 21 22 health plans. This Act is not intended to create an 23 entitlement.
