The Inclusion of Women and Minorities in 4 5 Clinical Research Act is amended by changing Sections 5 and 10 6 as follows: 7 (30 ILCS 785/5) Sec. 5. Definitions. In this Act: 8 "Grantee" means any qualified public, private, 9 not-for-profit agency or individual, including, but not 10 limited to, a college, university, hospital, laboratory, 11 research institution, local health department, voluntary 12 health agency, health maintenance organization, corporation, 13 student, fellow, or entrepreneur, conducting clinical research 14 15 using State funds. A grantee may also be a corporation that is 16 headquartered in Illinois and that conducts research using State funds. 17 "Minority group" means a group that is a readily 18 identifiable subset of the U.S. population that is 19 distinguished by racial, ethnic, or cultural heritage. The 20 21 following racial and ethnic categories shall be used as 22 guidelines: (1) "American Indian or Alaskan Native" means a person 23 having origins in any of the original native peoples of 24

1	North America and who maintains a cultural identification
2	through tribal affiliation or community recognition.
3	(2) "Asian or Pacific Islander" means a person having
4	origins in any of the original peoples of the Far East,
5	Southeast Asia, the Indian subcontinent, or the Pacific
6	Islands, including, but not limited to, China, India,
7	Japan, Korea, the Philippine Islands, and Samoa.
8	(3) "Black" means someone not of Hispanic origin having
9	origins in any of the black racial groups of Africa.
10	(4) "Hispanic" means a person of Mexican, Puerto Rican,
11	Cuban, Central or South American, or other Spanish culture
12	or origin, regardless of race is defined as in the 2000
13	National Institutes of Health guidelines.
14	"Project of clinical research" includes a clinical trial.

17	Sec. 10. Inclusion of women and minorities. Except as
18	provided in Section 15 or 30, in conducting or supporting a
19	project of clinical research, a grantee must do all of the
20	following:
21	(1) Ensure that women, including, but not limited to,
22	women over the age of 40 years, are included as subjects in
23	each research project.
24	(2) Ensure that members of minority groups are included
25	as subjects in each research project.
26	(3) Conduct or support outreach programs for the
27	recruitment of women and members of minority groups as
28	subjects in projects of clinical research.
29	(4) Comply with the National Institutes of Health
30	Guidelines on the Inclusion of Women and Minorities in
31	Clinical Research.
