AN ACT in regard to highways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Toll Highway Act is amended by changing
Section 4 as follows:

6 (605 ILCS 10/4) (from Ch. 121, par. 100-4)

Sec. 4. Of the directors appointed by the Governor, one such director shall be appointed by the Governor as chairman and shall hold office for 4 years from the date of his appointment, and until his successor shall be duly appointed and qualified, but shall be subject to removal by the Governor for incompetency, neglect of duty or malfeasance.

13 The chairman shall preside at all meetings of the Board Directors of the Authority; shall exercise general 14 of 15 supervision over all powers, duties, obligations and 16 functions of the Authority; and shall approve or disapprove all resolutions, by-laws, rules, rates and regulations made 17 18 and established by the Board of Directors, and if he shall approve thereof, he shall sign the same, and such as he shall 19 20 not approve he shall return to the Board of Directors with his objections thereto in writing at the next regular meeting 21 22 of the Board of Directors occurring after the passage thereof. Such veto may extend to any one or more items 23 contained in such resolution, by-law, 24 rule, rate or regulation, or to its entirety; and in case the veto extends 25 to a part of such resolution, by-law, rule, rate 26 or 27 regulation, the residue thereof shall take effect and be in force, but in case the chairman shall fail to return any 28 29 resolution, by-law, rule, rate or regulation with his objections thereto by the time aforesaid, he shall be deemed 30 to have approved the same, and the same shall take effect 31

1 accordingly. Upon the return of any resolution, by-law, rule, rate or regulation by the chairman, the vote by which the 2 3 same was passed shall be reconsidered by the Board of 4 Directors, and if upon such reconsideration two-thirds of all 5 the Directors agree by yeas and nays to pass the same, it 6 shall go into effect notwithstanding the chairman's refusal 7 to approve thereof.

The chairman shall receive a salary of \$18,000 per annum, 8 9 or as set by the Compensation Review Board, whichever is 10 greater, payable in monthly installments, together with 11 reimbursement for necessary expenses incurred in the performance of his duties. The chairman shall be eligible for 12 13 reappointment.
