- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Act on the Aging is amended by
- 5 changing Section 2 as follows:
- 6 (20 ILCS 105/2) (from Ch. 23, par. 6102)
- 7 Sec. 2. <u>Purpose.</u> The ability of the constantly
- 8 increasing number of aged in the State to maintain
- 9 self-sufficiency and personal well-being with the dignity to
- 10 which their years of labor entitle them and to realize their
- 11 maximum potential as creative and productive individuals are
- 12 matters of profound import and concern for all of the people
- of this State.
- 14 The purposes of this Act are to provide a comprehensive
- 15 and coordinated service system for the State's aging
- 16 population, giving high priority to those persons in greatest
- 17 need; to conduct studies and research into the needs and
- 18 problems of the aging; and to insure participation by the
- 19 aging in the planning and operation of all phases of the
- 20 system.
