AN ACT in relation to employment.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Department of Employment Security Law of
the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois is amended by
adding Section 1005-155 as follows:

8 Sec. 1005-155. Illinois Employment and Training Centers 9 report. The Department of Employment Security, or the State agency responsible for the oversight of the federal Workforce 10 Investment Act of 1998 if that agency is not the Department 11 of Employment Security, shall prepare a report for the 12 13 Governor and the General Assembly regarding the progress of the Illinois Employment and Training Centers in serving 14 individuals with disabilities. The report must include, but 15 is not limited to, the following: (i) the number of 16 individuals referred to the Illinois Employment and Training 17 Centers by the Department of Human Services Office of 18 Rehabilitation Services; (ii) the total number of disabled 19 individuals served by the Illinois Employment and Training 20 Centers; (iii) the number of disabled individuals served in 21 federal Workforce Investment Act of 1998 employment and 22 training programs; (iv) the number of individuals with 23 disabilities annually placed in jobs by the Illinois 24 Employment and Training Centers; and (v) the number of 25 individuals with disabilities referred by the Illinois 26 Employment and Training Centers to the Department of Human 27 Services Office of Rehabilitation Services. The report is due 28 by December 31, 2004 based on the previous State program year 29 of July 1 through June 30, and is due annually thereafter. 30 "Individuals with disabilities" are defined as those who 31

- 3 Act, for the purposes of this Law.
