Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Code of Civil Procedure is amended by
changing Section 1-106 as follows:

(735 ILCS 5/1-106) (from Ch. 110, par. 1-106) 6 7 Sec. 1-106. Act to be liberally construed. This Act shall be liberally construed, to the end that controversies may be 8 speedily and finally determined according to the substantive 9 rights of the parties. The rule that statutes in derogation 10 11 of the common law must be strictly construed does not apply to this Act or to the rules made in relation to this Act 12 13 thereto.
