- 1 AN ACT in relation to highways.
- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Toll Highway Act is amended by adding
- 5 Section 8.1 as follows:
- 6 (605 ILCS 10/8.1 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 8.1. Inspector General.</u>
- 8 (a) The Governor shall nominate and, by and with the
- 9 <u>advice and consent of the Senate, appoint an Inspector</u>
- 10 General who shall have the authority to conduct
- 11 <u>investigations into allegations or incidents of waste, fraud,</u>
- 12 and financial mismanagement in Authority operations involving
- 13 <u>an Authority employee or contractor. The Inspector General</u>
- 14 shall make recommendations to the Authority regarding his or
- 15 <u>her investigations</u>. The Inspector General shall be appointed
- 16 <u>for a term of 4 years. The Inspector General shall be</u>
- 17 <u>independent of the operations of the Authority and perform</u>
- other duties as requested by the Authority.
- 19 <u>(b) The Inspector General shall have access to all</u>
- 20 <u>information and personnel necessary to perform the duties of</u>
- 21 the office. If the Inspector General determines that a
- 22 possible criminal act has been committed or that special
- 23 <u>expertise is required in the investigation, he or she shall</u>
- 24 <u>immediately notify the Department of State Police. All</u>

12	(e) The Inspector General shall provide to the Authority
13	and the General Assembly a summary of reports and
14	investigations made under this Section for the previous
15	fiscal year no later than January 1 of each year. The
16	summaries shall detail the final disposition of the Inspector
17	General's recommendations. The summaries shall not contain
18	any confidential or identifying information concerning the
19	subjects of the reports and investigations. The summaries
20	shall also include detailed, recommended administrative
21	actions and matters for consideration by the General
