AN ACT concerning higher education.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The University of Illinois Act is amended by 5 adding Section 25 as follows:

6 (110 ILCS 305/25 new)

Sec. 25. Limitation on tuition increase. This Section 7 8 applies only to those students who first enroll after the 2003-2004 academic year. The tuition charged an undergraduate 9 student who is an Illinois resident shall not exceed the 10 amount that the student was charged at the time he or she 11 first enrolled at the University as an Illinois resident if 12 13 that student first enrolled not more than 3 and one-half academic years before. However, if the student changes majors 14 during this time period, the tuition charged the student 15 shall equal the amount the student would have been charged 16 had he or she been admitted to the changed major when he or 17 18 she first enrolled.

Section 10. The Southern Illinois University ManagementAct is amended by adding Section 15 as follows:

(110 ILCS 520/15 new)

Sec. 15. Limitation on tuition increase. This Section 22 applies only to those students who first enroll after the 23 2003-2004 academic year. The tuition charged an undergraduate 24 student who is an Illinois resident shall not exceed the 25 26 amount that the student was charged at the time he or she 27 first enrolled at the University as an Illinois resident if that student first enrolled not more than 3 and one-half 28 academic years before. However, if the student changes majors 29

1 during this time period, the tuition charged the student 2 shall equal the amount the student would have been charged 3 had he or she been admitted to the changed major when he or 4 she first enrolled.

The tuition charged an 10 undergraduate student who is an Illinois resident shall not 11 exceed the amount that the student was charged at the time he 12 or she first enrolled at the University as an Illinois 13 14 resident if that student first enrolled not more than 3 and 15 one-half academic years before. However, if the student changes majors during this time period, the tuition charged 16 17 the student shall equal the amount the student would have been charged had he or she been admitted to the changed major 18 19 when he or she first enrolled.

20 Section 40. The Northern Illinois University Law is 21 amended by adding Section 30-130 as follows:

23 Sec. 30-130. Limitation on tuition increase. This Section applies only to those students who first enroll after 24 the 2003-2004 academic year. The tuition charged an 25 undergraduate student who is an Illinois resident shall not 26 27 exceed the amount that the student was charged at the time he or she first enrolled at the University as an Illinois 28 resident if that student first enrolled not more than 3 and 29 one-half academic years before. However, if the student 30

The tuition charged an 10 undergraduate student who is an Illinois resident shall not 11 exceed the amount that the student was charged at the time he 12 or she first enrolled at the University as an Illinois 13 resident if that student first enrolled not more than 3 and 14 one-half academic years before. However, if the student 15 changes majors during this time period, the tuition charged 16 17 the student shall equal the amount the student would have been charged had he or she been admitted to the changed major 18 19 when he or she first enrolled.
