- 1 AN ACT in relation to fire fighters.
- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Fire Investigation Act is amended by
- 5 adding Section 9f as follows:
- 6 (425 ILCS 25/9f new)
- Sec. 9f. The owner or occupier of the premises and his or
- 8 <u>her agents owe fire fighters who are on the premises in the</u>
- 9 performance of their official duties conducting fire
- 10 <u>investigations or inspections or responding to fire alarms or</u>
- 11 <u>actual fires on the premises a duty of reasonable care in the</u>
- 12 <u>maintenance of the premises according to applicable fire</u>
- 13 <u>safety codes</u>, <u>regulations</u>, <u>ordinances</u>, <u>and generally</u>
- 14 applicable safety standards, including any decisions by the
- 15 <u>Illinois courts. The owner or occupier of the premises and</u>
- 16 <u>his or her agents are not relieved of the duty of reasonable</u>
- 17 <u>care if the fire fighter is injured due to the lack of</u>
- 18 <u>maintenance of the premises in the course of responding to a</u>
- 19 <u>fire</u>, <u>false alarm</u>, <u>or his or her inspection or investigation</u>
- of the premises.
- 21 For purposes of this Section, the term "premises" means
- 22 any building or structure or the real property upon which the
- 23 <u>building or structure is situated.</u>
- 24 This Section applies to all causes of action that have
- 25 <u>accrued</u>, will accrue, or are currently pending before a court
- of competent jurisdiction, including courts of review.
- 27 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 28 becoming law.
