- 4 Section 5. The Medical Practice Act of 1987 is amended
- 5 by changing Section 10 as follows:
- 6 (225 ILCS 60/10) (from Ch. 111, par. 4400-10)
- 7 (Section scheduled to be repealed on January 1, 2007)
- 8 Sec. 10. <u>Duties of the Department</u>. The Department shall:
- 9 (A) Make rules for establishing reasonable minimum
- 10 standards of educational requirements to be observed by
- 11 medical, osteopathic and chiropractic colleges.÷
- 12 (B) Effectuate the policy of the State of Illinois that
- 13 the quality of medical training is an appropriate concern in
- 14 the recruiting, licensing, credentialing and participation in
- 15 residency programs of physicians. However, it is
- 16 inappropriate to discriminate against any physician because
- 17 of national origin or geographic location of medical
- 18 education.÷
- 19 (C) Formulate rules and regulations required for the
- 20 administration of this Act.
