- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Conveyances Act is amended by changing
- 5 Section 4 as follows:
- 6 (765 ILCS 5/4) (from Ch. 30, par. 4)
- 7 Sec. 4. <u>Conveyor not in possession of lands.</u> Any person
- 8 claiming right or title to lands, tenements or hereditaments,
- 9 although he, she or they may be out of possession, and
- 10 notwithstanding there may be an adverse possession thereof,
- 11 may sell, convey and transfer his or her interest in and to
- 12 the same, in as full and complete a manner as if he or she
- 13 were in the actual possession of the lands and premises
- intended to be conveyed; and the grantee or grantees shall
- 15 have the same right of action for the recovery thereof, and
- 16 shall in all respects derive the same benefit and advantage
- 17 therefrom, as if the grantor or grantors had been in the
- 18 actual possession at the time of executing the conveyance.
