AN ACT in relation to vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by
5 changing Sections 3-626, 3-628, 3-638, 3-642, 3-645, 3-647,
6 3-650, and 3-806.4 as follows:

8 Sec. 3-626. Korean War Veteran license plates.

9 (a) In addition to any other special license plate, the Secretary, upon receipt of 10 all applicable fees and applications made in the form prescribed by the Secretary of 11 State, may issue special registration plates designated as 12 13 Korean War Veteran license plates to residents of Illinois who participated in the United States Armed Forces during the 14 15 Korean War. The special plate issued under this Section shall be affixed only to passenger vehicles of the first 16 division, motorcycles, motor vehicles of the second division 17 18 weighing not more than 8,000 pounds, and recreational vehicles as defined by Section 1-169 of this Code. Plates 19 20 issued under this Section shall expire according to the staggered multi-year procedure established by Section 3-414.1 21 22 of this Code.

(b) The design, color, and format of the plates shall be 23 wholly within the discretion of the Secretary of State. 24 The Secretary may, in his or her discretion, allow the plates to 25 be issued as vanity plates or personalized in accordance with 26 27 Section 3-405.1 of this Code. The plates are not required to designate "Land Of Lincoln", as prescribed in subsection (b) 28 29 of Section 3-412 of this Code. The Secretary shall prescribe the eligibility requirements and, in his or her discretion, 30 shall approve and prescribe stickers or decals as provided 31

1 under Section 3-412.

2 (c) An applicant shall be charged a \$15 fee for original issuance in addition to the applicable registration fee. Of 3 4 this additional fee, \$13 shall be deposited into the Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund and \$2 shall be 5 б deposited into the Korean War Memorial Construction Fund. 7 For--each--registration-renewal-period,-a-\$2-fee,-in-addition 8 to-the-appropriate-registration-fee,--shall--be--charged--and 9 shall--be--deposited--into--the--Secretary--of--State-Special License-Plate-Fund-10

11 (d) The Korean War Memorial Construction Fund is created 12 as a special fund in the State treasury. All moneys in the Korean War Memorial Construction Fund shall, subject to 13 appropriation, be used by the Department of Veteran Affairs 14 to provide grants for construction of the Korean War Memorial 15 16 to be located at Oak Ridge Cemetery in Springfield, Illinois. Upon the completion of the Memorial, the Department of 17 Veteran Affairs shall certify to the State Treasurer that the 18 construction of the Memorial has been completed. 19 Upon the certification by the Department of Veteran Affairs, the State 20 21 Treasurer shall transfer all moneys in the Fund and any 22 future deposits into the Fund into the Secretary of State 23 Special License Plate Fund.

An individual who has been issued Korean War Veteran 24 (e) 25 license plates for a vehicle and who has claimed and received a grant under the Senior Citizens and Disabled Persons 26 Property Tax Relief and Pharmaceutical Assistance Act shall 27 pay the original issuance and the regular annual fee for the 28 registration of the vehicle as provided in Section 3-806.3 of 29 30 this Code in addition to the fees specified in subsection (c) of this Section. 31

Sec. 3-628. Bronze Star plates.

2 (a) Beginning January 1, 1996, in addition to any other special license plate, the Secretary, upon receipt of all 3 4 applicable fees and applications made in the form prescribed by the Secretary of State, may issue special registration 5 plates to residents of Illinois who have been awarded the 6 7 Bronze Star by the United States Armed Forces. The special plate issued under this Section shall be affixed only to 8 9 passenger vehicles of the first division, motorcycles, or motor vehicles of the second division weighing not more than 10 11 8,000 pounds. Plates issued under this Section shall expire according to the staggered multi-year procedure established 12 by Section 3-414.1 of this Code. 13

The design, color, and format of the plates shall be 14 (b) 15 wholly within the discretion of the Secretary of State. The 16 Secretary may, in his or her discretion, allow the plates to be issued as vanity plates or personalized in accordance with 17 18 Section 3-405.1 of this Code. The plates are not required to 19 designate "Land Of Lincoln", as prescribed in subsection (b) of Section 3-412 of this Code. The Secretary shall prescribe 20 21 the eligibility requirements and, in his or her discretion, 22 shall approve and prescribe stickers or decals as provided 23 under Section 3-412.

24 (c) An applicant shall be charged a \$15 fee for original
25 issuance in addition to the appropriate registration fee.

1 (a) In addition to any other special license plate, the 2 Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and applications made in the form prescribed by the Secretary of 3 4 State, may issue U.S. Veteran license plates to residents of Illinois who meet eligibility requirements prescribed by the 5 6 Secretary of State. The special U.S. Veteran plate issued under this Section shall be affixed only to passenger 7 8 vehicles of the first division, motorcycles, and motor vehicles of the second division weighing not more than 8,000 9 pounds. Plates issued under this Section shall 10 expire 11 according to the staggered multi-year procedure established by Section 3-414.1 of this Code. 12

The design, color, and format of the plates shall be 13 (b) wholly within the discretion of the Secretary of State. 14 The 15 Secretary may, in his or her discretion, allow the plates to 16 be issued as vanity plates or personalized in accordance with Section 3-405.1 of this Code. The plates are not required to 17 designate "Land Of Lincoln", as prescribed in subsection (b) 18 19 of Section 3-412 of this Code. The Secretary shall prescribe the eligibility requirements and, in his or her discretion, 20 21 shall approve and prescribe stickers or decals as provided 22 under Section 3-412.

33 (a) The Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees

1 and applications made in the form prescribed by the 2 Secretary, may issue special registration plates to residents of Illinois who have been awarded the Silver Star by the 3 4 United States Armed Forces. The special plate issued under this Section shall be affixed only to passenger vehicles of 5 6 the first division, motorcycles, or motor vehicles of the 7 second division weighing not more than 8,000 pounds. Plates 8 issued under this Section shall expire according to the 9 staggered multi-year procedure established by Section 3-414.1 of this Code. 10

11 (b) The design, color, and format of the plates shall be wholly within the discretion of the Secretary. The Secretary 12 may, in his or her discretion, allow the plates to be issued 13 as vanity plates or personalized in accordance with Section 14 The plates are not required to 15 3-405.1 of this Code. 16 designate "Land Of Lincoln", as prescribed in subsection (b) of Section 3-412 of this Code. The Secretary shall prescribe 17 the eligibility requirements and, in his or her discretion, 18 19 shall approve and prescribe stickers or decals as provided under Section 3-412. 20

The special Vietnam Veteran plate 3 4 issued under this Section shall be affixed only to passenger 5 vehicles of the first division, motorcycles, and motor б vehicles of the second division weighing not more than 8,000 Plates issued under this Section shall expire 7 pounds. 8 according to the staggered multi-year procedure established 9 by Section 3-414.1 of this Code.

30 (a) In addition to any other special license plate, the
31 Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and
32 applications made in the form prescribed by the Secretary of
33 State, may issue World War II Veteran license plates to

1 residents of Illinois who meet eligibility requirements 2 prescribed by the Secretary of State. The special World War II Veteran plate issued under this Section shall be affixed 3 4 vehicles of the first division, only to passenger 5 motorcycles, and motor vehicles of the second division б weighing not more than 8,000 pounds. Plates issued under this 7 Section shall expire according to the staggered multi-year procedure established by Section 3-414.1 of this Code. 8

9 The design, color, and format of the plates shall be (b) wholly within the discretion of the Secretary of State. 10 The 11 Secretary may, in his or her discretion, allow the plates to be issued as vanity plates or personalized in accordance with 12 Section 3-405.1 of this Code. The plates are not required to 13 designate "Land Of Lincoln", as prescribed in subsection (b) 14 of Section 3-412 of this Code. Sec. 3-650. Army Combat Veteran license plates.

(a) In addition to any other special license plate, the
Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and
applications made in the form prescribed by the Secretary of
State, may issue Army Combat Veteran license plates to
residents of Illinois who meet eligibility requirements

1 prescribed by the Secretary of State. The special Army 2 Combat Veteran plate issued under this Section shall be affixed only to passenger vehicles of the first division, 3 4 motorcycles, and motor vehicles of the second division weighing not more than 8,000 pounds. 5 Plates issued under 6 this Section shall expire according to the staggered 7 multi-year procedure established by Section 3-414.1 of this 8 Code.

9 (b) The plates shall display the Army Combat Infantry In all other respects, the design, color, and format 10 Badge. 11 of the plates shall be within the discretion of the Secretary of State. The Secretary may, in his or her discretion, allow 12 the plates to be issued as vanity plates or personalized in 13 accordance with Section 3-405.1 of this Code. The plates are 14 15 not required to designate "Land Of Lincoln", as prescribed in 16 subsection (b) of Section 3-412 of this Code. The Secretary shall prescribe the eligibility requirements and, in his or 17 her discretion, shall approve and prescribe stickers or 18 19 decals as provided under Section 3-412.

(c) An applicant shall be charged a \$15 fee for original 20 21 issuance in addition to the applicable registration fee. 22 This additional fee shall be deposited into the Secretary of 23 State Special License Plate Fund. 29 (625 ILCS 5/3-806.4) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 3-806.4) Sec. 3-806.4. Gold Star recipients. Commencing with the 30 application, 31 1991 registration year, upon proper the Secretary of State shall issue one pair of registration 32 33 plates to any Illinois resident, who as the surviving widow

1 or widower, or in the absence thereof, as the surviving 2 parent, is awarded the Gold Star by the United States in recognition of spouses or children who served in the Armed 3 4 Forces of the United States and lost their lives while in service whether in peacetime or war. If the parent no longer 5 survives, the Secretary of State shall issue the plates to a 6 7 surviving sibling, of the person who served in the Armed Forces, who is an Illinois resident. No more than one set of 8 9 plates shall be issued for each Gold Star awarded, and only one surviving parent, or in the absence of a surviving 10 11 parent, only one surviving sibling shall be issued a set of 12 registration plates, except for those surviving parents who, 13 as recipients of the Gold Star, have legally separated or divorced, in which case each surviving parent shall be 14 15 allowed one set of registration plates. Registration plates 16 issued under this Section shall be for first division vehicles and second division vehicles of 8,000 pounds or 17 less. An applicant shall be charged a \$15 fee for the 18 19 original issuance in addition to the appropriate registration fee which shall be deposited into the Road Fund to help 20 21 defray the administrative processing costs. For--each 22 registration-renewal-period,-a-\$2-fee,--in--addition--to--the 23 appropriate---registration----fee,----shall--be--charged--and 24 deposited-into-the-Road-Fund-
