AN ACT in relation to penal ordinances.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Municipal Code is amended by
adding Section 11-1-12 as follows:

6 (65 ILCS 5/11-1-12 new)

Sec. 11-1-12. Local retail theft ordinance. The 7 8 corporate authorities of a municipality may, by ordinance, declare retail theft, as defined by the Criminal Code of 9 1961, to be unlawful. The ordinance, however, may not apply 10 to any individual who has previously been convicted of any 11 type of theft, robbery, armed robbery, burglary, residential 12 13 burglary, possession of burglary tools, or home invasion, or in any case where the theft is of property with a full retail 14 15 value in excess of \$150.

The corporate authorities of any municipality that adopts 16 a retail theft ordinance under this Section shall keep a 17 record of all individuals who are convicted under the 18 ordinance and shall make the record available for public 19 20 inspection and copying on the payment of the cost of reproducing the record. The municipality must, in a timely 21 manner, furnish a copy of all retail theft ordinance 22 convictions to the office of the State's Attorney of the 23 county in which the municipality is located. 24
