- 1 AN ACT in relation to penal ordinances.
- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Municipal Code is amended by
- 5 adding Section 11-1-12 as follows:
- 6 (65 ILCS 5/11-1-12 new)
- 7 Sec. 11-1-12. Local retail theft ordinance. The
- 8 corporate authorities of a municipality may, by ordinance,
- 9 <u>declare retail theft, as defined by the Criminal Code of</u>
- 10 1961, to be unlawful. The ordinance, however, may not apply
- 11 to any individual who has previously been convicted of any
- 12 type of theft, robbery, armed robbery, burglary, residential
- burglary, possession of burglary tools, or home invasion, or
- in any case where the theft is of property with a full retail
- 15 <u>value in excess of \$150.</u>
- The corporate authorities of any municipality that adopts
- 17 <u>a retail theft ordinance under this Section shall keep a</u>
- 18 record of all individuals who are convicted under the
- 19 <u>ordinance and shall make the record available for public</u>
- 20 <u>inspection and copying on the payment of the cost of</u>
- 21 reproducing the record. The municipality must, in a timely
- 22 <u>manner</u>, <u>furnish</u> a copy of all retail theft ordinance
- 23 <u>convictions to the office of the State's Attorney of the</u>
- 24 <u>county in which the municipality is located.</u>
