AN ACT concerning municipalities.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Municipal Code is amended by
changing Section 8-8-3.5 as follows:

6 (65 ILCS 5/8-8-3.5)

7 Sec. 8-8-3.5. Tax Increment financing report; evaluation
8 task force.

(a) The reports filed under subsection (d) of Section 9 11-74.4-5 of the Tax Increment Allocation Redevelopment Act 10 and the reports filed under subsection (d) of Section 11 11-74.6-22 of the Industrial Jobs Recovery Law in the 12 13 Illinois Municipal Code must be separate from any other annual report filed with the Comptroller. The Comptroller 14 must, in cooperation with reporting municipalities, create a 15 16 format for the reporting of information described in paragraphs (1.5) and (5) and in subparagraph (G) of paragraph 17 (7) of subsection (d) of Section 11-74.4-5 of the Tax 18 Increment Allocation Redevelopment Act and the information 19 20 described in paragraphs (1.5) and (5) and in subparagraph (G) of paragraph (7) of subsection (d) of Section 11-74.6-22 of 21 22 the Industrial Jobs Recovery Law that facilitates consistent reporting among the reporting municipalities. The Comptroller 23 may allow these reports to be filed electronically and may 24 display the report, or portions of the report, electronically 25 via the Internet. All reports filed under this Section must 26 27 be made available for examination and copying by the public at all reasonable times. 28

29 (b) There is established the Tax Increment Effectiveness
 30 Evaluation Task Force to evaluate the effectiveness of tax
 31 increment financing districts in Illinois. The Task Force

1 shall consist of 21 members as follows: the Director 2 Commerce and Community Affairs or his or her designee; the 3 State Comptroller or his or her designee; the State 4 Superintendent of Education or his or her designee; 3 member 5 appointed by the Director of Commerce and Community Affair 6 who represent small and large downstate municipalities 7 Illinois that have tax increment financing districts; or 8 member with experience with tax increment financing appoint 9 by each of the following municipal organizations: to
3 <u>State Comptroller or his or her designee; the Sta</u> 4 <u>Superintendent of Education or his or her designee; 3 member</u> 5 <u>appointed by the Director of Commerce and Community Affa</u> 6 <u>who represent small and large downstate municipalities</u> 7 <u>Illinois that have tax increment financing districts; of</u> 8 <u>member with experience with tax increment financing appoint</u>
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9 by each of the following municipal organizations: t
10 <u>Illinois Municipal League, the Illinois Tax Increme</u>
11 Association, the Northwest Municipal Conference, the We
12 <u>Central Municipal Conference, and the South Suburban Mayor</u>
13 one member representing the City of Chicago appointed by t
14 Mayor of Chicago; 2 members appointed by the Director
15 <u>Commerce and Community Affairs who are lawyers, planners,</u>
16 other professionals with extensive experience with Illing
17 <u>tax increment financing programs; one member appointed by t</u>
18 Director of Revenue; and 6 members appointed by the Govern
19 as follows: (i) 2 residents of Cook County; (ii) 2 resider
20 of any of the following counties: DuPage, Kane, Lak
21 McHenry, and Will; and (iii) 2 residents of any oth
22 <u>counties in the State. All members appointed by the Govern</u>
23 must be either (i) a resident of a tax increment finance
24 <u>district or (ii) a representative of a community organization</u>
25 with an interest in tax increment financing. The members
26 the Task Force shall serve without compensation. The Ta
27 Force shall meet initially at the call of the Director
28 <u>Commerce and Community Affairs, shall select one member</u>
29 chairperson at its initial meeting, and shall thereafter me
30 <u>at the call of the chairperson.</u>
31 The duties of the Task Force shall include the following
32 (1) Study the statewide tax increment report
33 <u>systems of other states.</u>

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(2) Based on the study in item (1), determine the

1	best methods to use to evaluate the effectiveness of a
2	tax increment financing district.
3	(3) Assess the availability of the information
4	necessary to establish a system for evaluating the
5	effectiveness of tax increment financing districts.
б	(4) Determine the methods that must be used to
7	collect all relevant needed information.
8	(5) Assess the amount of time and money necessary
9	to establish a system for evaluating the effectiveness of
10	tax increment financing districts and if it would be
11	appropriate to phase in the system.
12	The Task Force shall prepare and submit a report to the
13	General Assembly and to the Governor no later than June 30,
14	2004 containing its recommendations for the establishment of
15	a system to evaluate the effectiveness of tax increment
16	<u>financing districts in Illinois.</u>
