- 1 AN ACT regarding higher education.
- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Criminal Code of 1961 is amended by adding
- 5 Section 17-2.5 as follows:
- 6 (720 ILCS 5/17-2.5 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 17-2.5. False academic degrees.</u>
- 8 (a) It is unlawful for a person to knowingly manufacture
- 9 or produce for profit or for sale a false academic degree,
- 10 <u>unless the degree explicitly states "for novelty purposes</u>
- 11 <u>only".</u>
- 12 (b) It is unlawful for a person to knowingly use a false
- 13 <u>academic degree for the purpose of obtaining employment or</u>
- 14 <u>admission to an institution of higher learning or admission</u>
- 15 <u>to an advanced degree program at an institution of higher</u>
- 16 <u>learning or for the purpose of obtaining a promotion or</u>
- 17 <u>higher compensation in employment.</u>
- 18 (c) Sentence. A person who violates this Section is
- 19 <u>guilty of a Class A misdemeanor.</u>
- 20 (d) In this Section:
- 21 <u>"False academic degree" means a certificate, diploma,</u>
- 22 <u>transcript</u>, or other document purporting to be issued by an
- 23 <u>institution of higher learning or purporting to indicate that</u>
- 24 <u>a person has completed an organized academic program of study</u>
- 25 <u>at an institution of higher learning when the person has not</u>
- 26 completed the organized academic program of study indicated
- 27 <u>on the certificate, diploma, transcript, or other document.</u>
- 28 <u>"Institution of higher learning" means a public or</u>
- 29 private college, university, or community college located in
- 30 the State of Illinois that is authorized by the Board of
- 31 <u>Higher Education or the Illinois Community College Board to</u>

- issue post-secondary degrees, or a public or private college, 1
- 2 university, or community college located anywhere in the
- 3 United States that is or has been legally constituted to
- offer degrees and instruction in its state of origin or 4
- 5 incorporation.
- 6 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 7 becoming law.
